DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (not limited to) Registered Nurse (RN) / Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)

- Assist the Director of Nursing & the Assistant Director of Nursing in directing the day-to-day functions of the nursing activities in accordance with Federal, State, and community guidelines and regulations. The nurse delegates responsibilities to nursing personnel for the direct nursing care of specific residents during each shift.
- Manage, administer, and record care given to residents.
- Commitment to person centered and resident directed care.
- Be a liaison for the primary care physicians, nursing staff, and family of the resident.
- Record and monitor progress of residents and communicate with physicians according to ECOJC policy.
- Ensures that all medications and treatments are administered as ordered and in a timely manner according to ECOJC policies and procedures.
- Ensures that procedures for storage and control of medication and supplies are being followed.
- Complete move-in assessments on all new move-ins & on residents returning to the community.
- Complete weekly skin assessments, wound assessments and quarterly assessments and another other assessment as required.
- Ensures that all transfer or discharge information is resident accurate information

- Ensures that resident's incidents and grievances are followed up by taking the appropriate actions and by reporting to the supervisor immediately
- Ensuring team members involved in providing care to residents are aware of the care plan and the resident's care plan is followed while providing daily care. Monitors and implements resident care plans and is responsible for the direct supervision of CCPs, CMAs, and Homemakers.
- Ensuring that team members involved in providing resident care are completing their assigned duties. Assist with tasks as needed.
