Residents and Families,

Late yesterday afternoon a resident on Millcreek became symptomatic and a point of care test was administered. Unfortunately, the test came back positive for COVID-19. This morning we received confirmation that this resident's laboratory PCR test confirmed the positive test result. Four residents on Millcreek are now considered positive for COVID-19. All four of the residents have been moved into an isolation area separate from the rest of the Millcreek residents and being cared for by a certified medication aide only caring for them with the Millcreek nurse continuing to oversee their care. All Millcreek residents and team members were immediately retested and no additional positives were identified at this time.

Unfortunately, Millcreek is only able to have outdoor visits for an additional 14 days. Thankfully the weather seems to be cooperating. Compassionate care visits will not be impacted. As a word of caution, additional positives could still result from the initial exposure and therefore there is a risk associated with these visits so we want to remind everyone to wear a well fitted mask at all times and use proper hand hygiene.

Cottage Creek and Mountain Chalet are able to continue indoor visits.

The clinic for COVID-19 booster vaccines will be held next week on Wednesday from 8:00 – 11:00 a.m. Individuals that qualify for the booster are 6 months post fully vaccination status with the Pfizer vaccine. Please assist the Life Coaches by completing the consent as soon as possible in order to ensure you or your loved one is able to get the booster.

Evergreen will be hosting a flu vaccine clinic on Thursday, the 14th of October from 8:00 – 11:00 a.m. The Life Coaches have sent consents and we strongly encourage you to sign and return them if you have not already done so.
