Important REMINDER

Dear Families,

We are thankful to be at a point in the pandemic where visitation has been fully reinstated, as connection to loved ones is critical to well-being. However, it is very important every visitor adheres to our core principles of infection prevention while at Evergreen.

Please remember the following during your visits:

- **Maintain 6 feet** from all other residents at all times (indoors and outside in the courtyard)
- **Wear your mask at all times**
- **If you are visiting with a resident in their room and they have a roommate, BOTH privacy curtains must be drawn**
- **You may not visit in dining rooms, or community rooms where other residents are present**

We are *required* to enforce these guidelines. We have the right to ask you to leave the community if you fail to comply as we must do everything possible to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at Evergreen.

The world outside of nursing homes has moved on in many ways, however, this pandemic is still a very real threat to the lives of those we serve. We are still mandated by several regulating bodies to follow and enforce protocols for the safety of residents. We thank you for partnering with us in this. We want you to be able to visit, so we thank you in advance for your understanding and your help with this.

We continue to strongly encourage the entire Evergreen family, including each of you, to continue to be vigilant and help us in preventing the spread of COVID-19. Wear your mask, even if it isn't required, as the CDC does recommend wearing a mask for both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. Practice good hand hygiene and physical distance from others at all times. Please continue to take all appropriate mitigation efforts and remind your loved ones to do the same.
